## ITF Junior Team Competitions



# **Team ID Regulation**

1. A Player and Captain must be dressed in clothing that displays the Nation's name on the back of the shirt/dress

***AND***

2. A Player and Captain must be dressed in National Colours

**Team Identification is mandatory at the Finals and at all Qualifying rounds of the ITF Junior Team Competitions.**

**National colours must be  
announced on the nomination form**



# National Team Colours

- ➔ **National Associations should use national team colours as defined for the country for Davis Cup and Fed Cup**
- ➔ If this is not possible, National Associations should use national team colours that are traditionally associated with the national sports teams of that country e.g. blue in Italy
- ➔ White is not to be nominated as the predominant colour of a shirt (it can be the predominant colour of the shorts/skirt) unless it is a colour traditionally associated with that country e.g. Germany
- ➔ Both shirts and shorts/skirt must adhere to the national colour guidelines
- ➔ Clothing can feature national colours in varying proportions and various styles
- ➔ Socks and shoes are not governed by this regulation
- ➔ In Doubles both members of the team must display the nation's name on the back of their shirt and dress in national colours.



# **Doubles Team Identification**

In addition to the team identification requirements indicated on the previous slides, it is emphasized that both members of the teams display the nation's name on the back of their shirt and dress in national colours.



## **COUNTRY NAMES**

| <b>Font:</b>          | Arial Black  |
| <b>Case:</b>          | Upper  |

| <b>Language:</b>      | English or<br>National i.e. Spain or<br>España                       |
| <b>Country:</b>       | Abbreviations will be<br>accepted but must be<br>approved by the ITF |
| <b>Letter colour:</b> | Non -Reflective,<br>plain, solid<br>black or solid<br>white. *       |

\*The ITF can be flexible on the font colour on a case by case basis provided all players on the same team use the same colour lettering.



**Shape of wording:**

Country names should be on a horizontal line with no arc.

**Height of letters:**

8 cm tall max.

3 cm short min.

**Spacing between letters:**

Variable

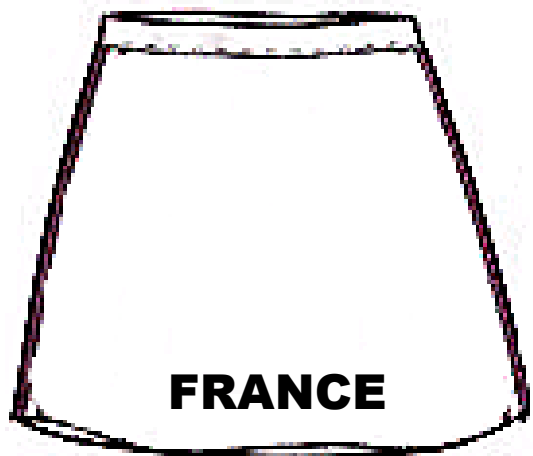
**Width of letters:**

Variable



**Height on Shirt:** Placed no lower than the armpits of the shirt

**Position on shirt:** Aligned centrally (avoiding the seam of the sleeve).



If a girl's shirt/dress is backless or too small for print, the country name must be placed on the back of the skirt.

It must be;

- a) In a horizontal line
- b) In Arial Black
- c) In contrasting colour to the skirt
- c) In Uppercase
- d) In the Roman alphabet
- e) In English or National language
- f) Non -Reflective, plain, solid black or solid white
- g) Abbreviations will be accepted but must be approved by ITF



# OPTIONAL ONLY



If flag is used it should be placed directly below country name and must be smaller in width than the country name. It should be placed no higher than the armpit line.
